CROCKER HIGHLANDS GUIDELINES FOR SCHOOL BEHAVIOR

School-wide expectations:

- Mutual respect
- Be kind and considerate
- Keep hands, feet, and objects to yourself
- Make good choices

Classroom behavior:

- Follow classroom rules.
- Listen to and follow teacher directions.
- Be respectful of other students and adults.

School building behavior:

- Students need to be supervised by an adult at all times: in the classroom, and on the yard.
- No admittance to building before or after school, unless accompanied by an adult or attending a class (rainy days—may enter building at 8:30).
- Respect every classroom's learning environment.
- Walk silently at all times in the hallways.
- During school hours, students must have passes to be in the hall.

Restroom Behavior

- Restroom guidelines: Go, Flush, Wash, Exit!
- Use the restroom closest to your classroom.
- Students use the restrooms on the playground during recess.

Lunchroom behavior:

- Walk while in the lunchroom.
- Sit at the table assigned to your class, unless otherwise directed.
- Make room for people in your class at your table.
- Raise your hand for permission to get up from seat.
- Do not throw food (to each other, or into the garbage cans).
- Due to allergies, we ask students not to share food with other students.
- Use guiet indoor voices.
- Clean up after yourself and look around your table to see what else you can pick up.
- Stay seated until dismissed by adult supervisor in the cafeteria to line up.
- Walk to the yard or the classroom with classmates.

Personal belongings:

- Do not bring toys, trading cards, candy, or gum to school.
- Cell phones must be turned off and kept in backpacks during school hours (see cell phone policy on website).

Yard behavior:

- Report problems to the yard teachers or to the student conflict managers.
- Listen to adults on the playground and follow their directions.
- Do not leave the playground or enter the building without permission.
- Eat only in designated areas (amphitheater and classroom lunch area).
- Chasing and tag games that interfere with others are not allowed.
- Play fighting, karate play, and gun play are not allowed.
- Wall ball only on designated wall areas (see yard map).
- Football allowed only when Coach B is present and supervising.
- We are not responsible for lost or stolen balls brought from home.
- Classroom balls should be labeled.
- Off limits area: behind Adventure Time portable and in the amphitheater.
- Freeze for the freeze whistle (three long blows).
- Walk to designated lines when second whistle blows (two short blows).

Structure area:

- Tag games in the structure area are not allowed.
- Balls or playground equipment are not to be used in the structure areas.
- Pushing or pulling students on the structure is not allowed.
- Go down the slide only—not up, and one person at a time.
- Stay off the top of the bars.
- Take turns on the bars and go in one direction only.
- Do not skip rungs on traveling bars.
