

CROCKER HIGHLANDS GUIDELINES FOR SCHOOL BEHAVIOR

School-wide expectations:

Mutual respect--do not use words, actions, or body language to humiliate or hurt others.

Keep hands, feet, and objects to yourself.

Classroom behavior:

Follow all class rules.

Listen to and follow teacher directions.

School building behavior:

Students need to be supervised by an adult at all times: in the classroom, and on the yard.

No admittance to building before or after school, unless accompanied by an adult or attending a class (rainy days—may enter building at 8:30).

Walk silently when passing through the hallways.

During school hours, students must have passes to be in the hall.

Use the bathroom closest to your classroom.

No playing in the bathroom.

Lunchroom behavior:

Walk while in the lunchroom.

Sit with your class—find a seat and stay there.

Make room for people in your class at your table.

Raise your hand for permission to get up from seat (no walking around).

Do not throw food (to each other, or into the garbage cans).

Do not share food.

Use quiet indoor voices—no yelling.

Clean up after yourself and look around your table to see what else you can pick up.

After lunch, walk up to yard with class.

Personal belongings:

Do not bring toys, trading cards, candy, or gum to school.

No video games at school.

Cell phones must be turned off and kept in backpacks during school hours, or the cell phones will be turned in to the office, and picked up after school.

Yard behavior:

Report problems to the yard teachers or the student conflict managers.

Listen to adults on the playground and follow their directions.

Do not leave the playground or enter the building without permission.

Do not eat on the playground.

Chasing and tag games that interfere with others are not allowed.

Play fighting, karate play, and gunplay are not allowed.

Wall ball only on the Adventure Time wall—not classroom walls.

Do not bring balls from home to school--class balls should be labeled.

**No playing between yellow lines--behind Adventure Time portable
or in the amphitheater.**

Freeze for the freeze whistle (three long blows).

Walk to designated lines when second whistle blows (two short blows).

Structure area:

Running in the structure area is not allowed.

Balls or playground equipment are not to be used in this area.

Pushing or pulling students on the structure is not allowed.

Go down the slide only—not up, and one person at a time.

Stay off the top of the bars.

Take turns on the structure.

Go in one direction on the bars.

Do not skip rungs on traveling bars.
