Clothes: A simple collared shirt or blouse in a color that complements the eyes or hair is best. Stay away from large patterns, words or graphics. Avoid spaghetti straps, halters and plunging necklines. Cartoon characters look better on TV than in a portrait.

Smile: Smile from your heart! Bring positive energy and your photographer will reflect it back for us all to enjoy!
