<u>Registration – August 7-9 (Times TBA) – On the playground – ALL STUDENTS MUST BE</u> FULLY IMMUNIZED , AND YOU MUST BRING IMMUNIZATION RECORDS TO REGISTRATION.

Please check the Google calendar on our website (<u>www.crockerschool.org</u>) for details about dates and times later this summer. You'll need to bring your child's immunization records, proof of a doctor's visit, your own ID, 3 proof of residency documents, a document verifying a dental exam if your child has been to one. There will also be registration documents to complete. Last year's registration documents are currently posted on our school's website and are unlikely to change. If they do, I'll post the new forms. We will also have paper copies at school. In the meantime, you may download copies of the Report of Health Exam for School Entry, Oral Health Assessment, and Authorization for Medication, and a California School Immunization form from our website at https://crockerschool.org/2018/04/14/incoming-kindergarten-welcome-letter/. If your doctor's office is willing to record when your child received immunizations on this document, it makes our data entry job at school much easier. If not, then please bring whatever record you do have. For information



about the immunizations required for school entry, please go to http://www.shotsforschool.org/k-12/. It is best to take care of immunizations by August 3.

To be a classroom volunteer, you'll need to register there and provide TB clearance from sometime within the past 4 years. If you anticipate driving on field trips, you'll also need to get a live scan done. We will bring a mobile live scan to the school one morning in August, but you're also welcome to take care of this on your own.
