

## Crocker Highlands Safety Patrol 2018-19



**Program Description:** This is a service opportunity for fifth graders at our school. Participating students will assist parent drivers and their children curbside at the two drop-off locations. They will wear brightly-colored vests so they can be easily seen, and they will be directed to remain on the sidewalk at all times.

**Responsibilities:** Their duties will include putting out safety cones, opening car doors, warmly greeting the drivers and students, assisting those who need help unloading backpacks, wishing the drivers a good day, and closing the car doors. Parent volunteers will continue to assist with street safety.

**Obligations:** Students who choose to become members of the Safety Patrol need to be at school by 8:20 on the days they are volunteering. They will get their vests, put out cones and report to their posts. When the bell rings, they must quickly drop off their vests, return the cones and go straight to class. It is important that they keep track of their shifts and arrive on time. The number of shifts each student works per month will depend upon the number of Safety Patrol members we have.

**Application Process:** Interested fifth graders must complete an application, which is on the next page of this document. They are due **Friday, 17th and must have a parent/guardian's signature**. Students who turn in applications will have a meeting during their lunch time that Friday. Morning Spanish will not start until the third week of school, so we'll adjust our schedule once we know whose availability will be changing. There is no limit to the number of students who may participate in this service program.
